I don't know about you, but I am LOVING this weather! My two favorite times of the year are Spring and Fall, where the weather is cool in the morning, but warm in the afternoon. Spring, especially, reminds me that God, the Lord of creation, is making *all things new*. We have a new song that we will be learning and focusing on in the month of May called "Thank You Jesus for the Blood." Pretty straight forward, right?

This song puts the focus on Jesus' blood which paid the price for all our sins. In the Old Testament, it is made clear that sin can only be atoned for by a sacrifice, specifically, a young lamb approximately one-year old that is without blemish or imperfection. Through Jesus' sacrifice, having lived a life that was without *blemish or imperfection*, the blood of the Lamb was spilled and has effectively paid the price for all of our sin. Praise the Lord! This song is a song of praise and thanks to Jesus for his sacrifice, that through him, our debt was paid and the chains of sin and shame have been broken *forever*. I want to encourage you to make it a point in your prayer life to specifically thank the Lord for the blood of Jesus Christ, whom without it, we would have no hope of redemption and eternal life.

Thank you for all of your support of this ministry and your pastors. I'm honored to serve where God has placed me, and to be a part of what God is doing here at Macedonia, and I'm truly excited to see what else He has in store!

Operation Christmas Child

If you have contributed any items for Operation Christmas Child, I want to say thank you from the bottom of my heart! We have received a great amount of donations, as our primary focus has been on "Wow" gifts these past four months. May is our month to focus on Monetary Contributions, but we are still taking donations of all kinds!

Like most pastors, I do NOT like asking folks for money. But instead, I would ask you to prayerfully consider a contribution to our Operation Christmas Child Fund, no matter the size you can contribute. Every penny that is given to this fund goes towards the cost of the boxes and shipping these boxes across seas. The cost of one box is \$0.66 and the cost to ship said box is \$10. Unfortunately, with inflation, these costs have gone up from last year. Even if you can only contribute \$10, that's one shoebox that will be delivered across the seas to a child, who will receive the gospel message of Jesus Christ because of YOUR contribution. What a blessing to be a part of that! Our goal for this year is 400 boxes. Making our shipping goal \$4,000 plus \$264 for exactly 400 boxes.

I don't just think, but I *know* that the Lord is capable of taking our contributions and our efforts and multiplying them. As the young boy gave his five loafs of bread and two fish, in faith, to feed the crowd of 5,000, so shall we give in faith! And I'm confident that the Lord will multiply our giving, all for His glory.
